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Profile

The centre is the human resource unit of the national TB & Leprosy program in Nigeria. It has the following responsibilities:

- Training of manpower & development of training materials and guidelines
- Referral hospital for TB & leprosy cases
- Provides an integrated TB/HIV diagnosis, treatment, care and support.
- Operational research relating to TBL.

Facilities:

- 140 beds capacity in patient care
- Laboratory services, routine, BSL 2&3 and PCR suites.
- GOPD with average 200 patients per day
- 3 classes (40- 60 participants capacity) and 1 auditorium(200-300 participants capacity)
- Hostel/guest house & sports /recreational facilities
- Library with Audio-visual room/computer resource centre with wireless internet facility
- 2 students buses

Training Methodology:

Active learning using principles of adult learning, experiential learning and problem based learning. Emphases are on skill acquisition based on authentic environment of the participants.



Training Fees

Information on all training fees is obtainable through the office of the principal and training Coordinator, the fees are review periodically with the NGO supporting program

Accommodation

Students stay at the hostel/guest house within the institution.

Health

In case of illness during training, students would be attended-to by the Medical Officer of the Centre, Students with chronic conditions should make adequate arrangements for treatment before coming and should inform the Principal of the Centre upon arrival.
